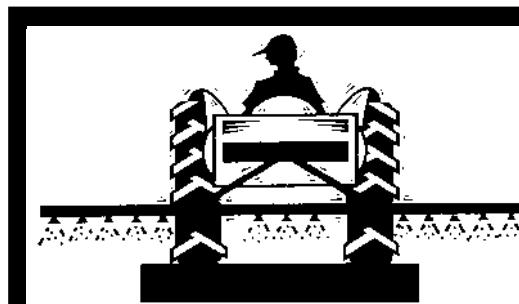
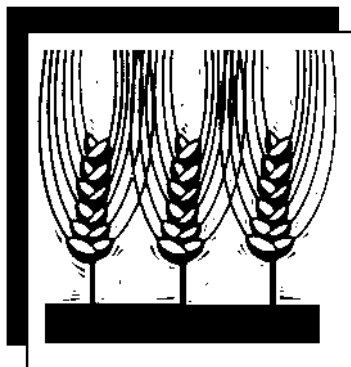

# Commercial Pesticide Applicator Short Course



The fee for this program is \$100 and includes breaks and 1 hour of University of Wyoming undergraduate college credit in PLNT 1150. Grading will be satisfactory or unsatisfactory and will be based on attendance and a score of 70% or better on the general exam.

A pesticide manual is available for \$30, which contains materials pertaining to the commercial pesticide applicator training short course. **The manual may be purchased prior to the short course or at the initial certification short course in Laramie.** Bring a note pad and a calculator.

The Wyoming Department of Agriculture will offer certification examinations for specific application categories following the short course on Friday December 12. There is a license fee of \$25 based on pass/fail of the exams. The fee is handled through the Wyoming Department of Agriculture. There is no license fee for city, county, state, or federal employees. **However, they will have to pay the registration fee of \$100.**
