

Guy Haggard Award

This award was initiated by the Wyoming Weed and Pest Council in 2007 in honor of Guy Haggard, a long time loyal friend of this organization.

Guy Haggard made noteworthy contributions to the Weed and Pest Program in his early years. Even after retirement Guy still comes to the meeting on his own merit. This award is given in honor of an individual who has provided motivation, friendship, loyalty, camaraderie, and support of the people and this organization.

The following guidelines should be considered by the Nomination and Selection committee in selecting a candidate for this award.

Recipient Criteria:

1. The recipient shall not be with the Wyoming Weed and Pest Council or this organization. (i.e.: Board member, Supervisor, Asst. Supervisor, employee etc.)
2. They should have been a loyal friend of the organization and impacted the lives of the people serving the Wyoming Weed and Pest Council in a friendly and momentous way.

Selection Committee

1. The award selection committee shall be one representative from each of the six District areas and a representative of the Executive Board. The selection committee shall be named by the Council President.
2. Be sure to notify the District and/or person so they are present to accept the award.

Nominations:

1. Nominations will come from a District.
2. Limit one nomination per District.
3. Secretary should have all nominations 40 days before the annual conference.
4. The selection process shall be completed 20 days prior to the annual conference so that the award can be ordered in time for the conference.
